1. Agenda - Review of Funding Matrix

AJA Funding priorities for consideration include:

- Academic
- **Band** has been an important program for AJA
- **Science** responding to request from school in the near term (next 2-3 years) and help prep students for high school science
- **Leadership** to support the AJA program identity and specialization
- Land-based learning developing program available to whole school
- **IT** ongoing needs
- Art

Discussion:

- Some have been well funded in previous years based on aligned goals and priorities of the school and the association
- Stanley Jones Association will likely have other funding priorities based on their curriculum (e.g. lower priority on leadership, no band program, lesser priority on science)
- Some categories (e.g. Misc) should be set high enough to cover what's already been approved for this year
- It's best practice to identify the funding matrix levels in September each year so that we can consider requests within the available funds
- There could be some fluidity in the categories as we negotiate requests throughout the year
- AJA Association may need to bridge the SJ Association this year as their casino funds will come in later than those for AJA
