Budget Overview:

- The school's budget is based on an enrollment of 486 students.
- Majority of the budget goes toward staffing (26 teachers, 5.1 support staff, 2.9 admin).
- After paying staff, there is approximately an extra \$55K to cover the remaining costs.
- **School Fees:** Efforts are being made to keep fees manageable. Feedback on the fees can be provided via the survey. Approved fees can be accessed on the CBE website.

New Music Teacher Update: Due to district-wide challenges in hiring, the school has not been able to secure a full-time music teacher. A part-time band teacher has been hired for the PM and is working with the grades 7,8,9 AJA students.

AM Music Teacher Vacancy: The position remains vacant. A retired teacher with a specialty in music has been providing guest instruction.
