7. School Learning Grounds Committee – Lisa Range

- a. It has been a busy 2 months of work on the school learning grounds committee. Lisa and a team of parents have prepared a request for proposal (RFP), Stella Grant, landscape designation was sent out. Looking for proposals, will need 3 quotes, from 3 firms. The Stella Grant is the first milestone. The grounds committee will be called the "School Learning Grounds Committee" going forward. Received a letter of support from Renfrew Community Association. There is an Instagram Page sj_learninggrounds. When asking students from SJ/AJA what they want to see on the grounds: response included more rocks, topography. Amphitheatre, shelter areas, trees, bushes, fruit bearing trees.
- **b.** This will be a multi-year project. Started in 2007, will need to include a transition plan for maintenance, mulch, weeding, etc.
